Online Entry Registration Instructions

Read below, then register entry information online before bringing items to Fair.

- **Read the complete rules, department and division descriptions, and entry information in this Premium List BEFORE going to online entry registration.**
- Then go to the [ONLINE ENTRY REGISTRATION](#) page (*available starting in May*)
- Click **Login/Logoff** and choose your **Type: Exhibitor**
 - Register using your First Name and Last Name and create a password (*write your password down or make sure it is something you will remember for future use.*) Fill in requested information, including email address. Click **Continue**.
- Click **Create Entries**. For each entry:
 - Select a **Department** ex.: *NW Woodworkers*
 - Select a **Division** ex.: *Woodworking - Division XXX*
 - Select a **Class** ex.: *class XX - Accessories, piece #1*
Fill in all requested information for the class(es) you are entering.
ex.: **Title:** *Child in Motion*
Description: *a marble maze encased in wood*
- When you have completed entering all your information, click **Continue** and follow the instructions to check out.
- Fill in "yes" at the statement to agree to all the terms and conditions of entry as defined in this prospectus.
- Click Submit.
- Please print and bring a copy of your online entry summary/receipt with your woodwork when you bring them to the Fair.

ENTRY DROP OFF DATES

Bring your entry items and online entry summary/receipt to the Hobby Hall on:

Friday, August 18, 9 am to 4 pm
Saturday, August 19, 9 am to 4 pm
Sunday, August 20, 12 pm to 6 pm

ALL CONDITIONS OF ELIGIBILITY, DIVISIONS, and INSTRUCTIONS must be followed to ensure your ENTRIES can be accepted for judging.

ENTRY GUIDELINES

Woodwork for entry must be delivered to and picked up from the Washington State Fair. Walk-in entrance is through the Gold Gate. You may drive to the Hobby Hall through the Gold Gate on 9th Ave SW, west of Meridian St. on entry and pick up days. Please mark your calendar with the "Release" dates.

ITEMS WILL NOT BE STORED IF THEY ARE NOT PICKED UP. ANYTHING REMAINING AFTER WEDNESDAY, SEPT. 27 WILL BE DONATED TO CHARITY OR DISCARDED..

ELIGIBILITY

- All woodwork entered must have been made by the entrant. The submission of another person's work is not allowed.
- Should questions arise concerning the eligibility of an entry, the Fair's decision will be respected as final. The Fair assumes no liability for breaches of copyright by exhibitor.
- Judges are selected from professionals or highly accredited amateur artists working within their field of expertise.

INSTRUCTIONS

- ***See step-by-step online entry registration instructions on page 3.*** Fill out registration forms and pay online by August 16. Bring a copy of your printed online registration summary/receipt with your items on receiving days.
- Each entrant shall be limited to ONE ENTRY PER CLASS as to enter more would result in competing against oneself. Entries may be reclassified by staff or judges.
- Entry fee: \$5.50 per piece in all divisions. Entry fees are non-refundable.
- All pieces intended to be hung must be delivered ready to hang.
- Please place a label on the back or bottom of piece, clearly showing woodworker's name.

CONDITIONS

- Although every precaution will be made to safeguard the artwork, the Washington State Fair will not be responsible for theft, damage (including glass breakage) or loss of entries. Each artist acknowledges that their woodwork will be displayed in public and there is no guarantee or assurances of any kind for the protection of the woodwork.
- The Fair reserves the right to not accept woodwork or remove any woodwork from display at any time, for any reason and at their own discretion.
- Entries cannot be accepted or returned by mail or common carrier.
